EXTRACT FROM ARTICLES OF ASSOCIATION

4. GENERAL MEMBERSHIP

The Association shall consist of Fellows, Members, Associate Members, Technician Engineer Members, Engineering Technician, Members, Students, Affiliates and Honorary Members.

5. REGISTER OF MEMBERS

The name, class, address and signature of every member shall be entered in the Register of the Association.

6. FELLOWS

Fellow shall comprise every person who has been elected to the class of Fellows, so long as his name is on the Register as such. A Fellow shall be a person who is distinguished by his work in engineering science of practice, or who has rendered conspicuous service to the Association, and such election shall be announced at the Annual General Meeting of the Association following.

7. MEMBERS

Members shall comprise every person who has been elected or transfer into the class of members, so long as his name is in the register as such. Every candidate for election or transfer into the class of Members shall satisfy the Executive Committee that he:

(a) Is actually engaged in the practice of professional engineering;

(b) Possesses a degree from a University or School of Engineering recognized by the Association, or an equivalent qualification;

8. ASSOCIATE MEMBERS

Associate Members shall comprise every person who has been elected or transferred into the class of Associate Members so long as his is on the register as such. Every candidate for election or transfer into the class of Associate Members shall satisfy the Executive Committee that he possesses a degree from a University or School of Engineering recognized, or an equivalent qualification.

9. TECHNICIAN ENGINEER MEMBERS

Technician Engineer Members shall comprise every person who has been elected or transferred to the class of Technician Engineer Members as long as his name is on the register as such. Every candidate for election or transfer into the class of Technician Engineer Members shall satisfy the Executive Committee that he possesses the Higher Technical Diploma from the University of Guyana, or an equivalent qualification. Every Technician Engineer Member shall apply for transfer to the Class of Associate Member as soon as he becomes eligible.

10. ENGINEERING TECHNICIAN MEMBERS

Engineering Technician Members shall comprise every person who has been elected or transferred to the class of Engineering Technician Members as long as his name is on the register as such. Every candidate for election or transfer into the class of Engineering Technician Members shall satisfy the Executive Committee that he possesses the General Technical Diploma from the University of Guyana, or an equivalent qualification. Every Engineering Technician Member shall apply for transfer to the Class of Associate Member or Technician Engineering Member as soon as he becomes eligible.

11. STUDENTS

Students shall comprise every person who has been elected into the class of Students so long as his name is on the register as such. Every candidate for election to the class of Students shall satisfy the Executive Committee that he/she is pursuing a course of study leading to qualification which satisfies the requirements for admission to the Class of Associate Member, Technician Engineering Member, or Engineering Technician Member.

12. AFFILIATES

Affiliates shall comprise every person who has been elected into the class of Affiliates so long as his name is on the register as such. Every candidate for election to the class of Affiliates shall not be qualified for admission into the Class of Fellows, Members, Associate Members, Technician Engineering Members, Engineering Technician Members or students and shall satisfy the Executive Committee that he/she:

(a) Has knowledge of the principles and practices of engineering and has spent at least five years in a responsible position in engineering works;

(b) Through his pursuits, practical experience and close association with professional engineers, he is qualified to contribute to the advancement of Engineering.

13. HONORARY MEMBERS

Honorary Members shall comprise every person who has been elected into the class of Honorary Members so long as his name is on the register as such. An Honorary Member shall be a person who has attained eminence or rendered outstanding service in the field of Engineering Science. Honorary members shall be elected by the Executive Committee.
